For survivors of sexual abuse, grief can be paralyzing. Rehtaeh Parsons experienced this first-hand: she was only 17 years old when she died by suicide after being gang raped and cyber-abused. Her mother, Leah, also had to deal with debilitating grief after her daughter's death. Not only was she learning to cope with an unbearable loss – at the same time, she had to be a voice for her daughter as her story unfolded in headlines all over the world.

Leah has since dedicated herself to helping other people navigate this trauma. She founded the Rehtaeh Parsons Society in honour of her daughter and offers workshops and presentations on topics like sexual violence, cyber abuse, mental health, suicide awareness, grief and healing. She's spoken at TedXThunderBay, met with heads of state, been a guest on the Dr. Phil Show (among many other media appearances), and has continued to be a voice for her daughter throughout her efforts to raise awareness.

By undertaking this journey, Leah has learned to face life's challenges with a new outlook, equipped with the tools for resilience, forgiveness and understanding. Leah travelled from a place of grief to a place of grace, and at this year's Little Warriors luncheon, she'll bring her inspiring message of hope and courage to everyone in attendance.
